Questions to Think and Talk About After Viewing the Video:

- How do signal words help Reed make sense of the text?
- How does it help your reading to locate cause and effect relationships?
- How does the Cause-Effect Chain Graphic Organizer help Reed determine important ideas?
- Why is it important for Reed to map out the events in the order they happened, rather than in the order they were written?
- Why might this process help you make sense of text?
- When might this process be useful?
- Think about one major event from (For example, the American Revolution, Demolition of the Berlin Wall, Global Warming). Then create a Cause-Effect Chain Graphic Organizer to show the causes that happened in order for the one event to occur.
- Challenge yourself to create one large graphic organizer for a cause/effect relationship of your(For example, the impact of the Beatles on popular music).
