

## **High Fantasy Activities**

Directions: On your own, create an outline for a story of High Fantasy. To accomplish this:

- 1. Decide on a setting for your story.
  - a. Where could your story take place?
  - b. What will the location look like?
  - c. How will your characters get to the location?
  - \*Try to be as descriptive as possible!
- 2. Decide on the characters for your story.
  - a. Who will be the hero (protagonist)?
  - b. Who will be the villain (antagonist)?
- c. Who will be the helpful friends, or companions, of the main character?
- \*What kinds of characters make sense for the setting you have developed? Try to be as descriptive as possible!
- 3. Decide on the problem of the story.
  - a. What is the villain trying to do that is so bad?
- b. What are some challenges or obstacles that the hero and his/her companions face as they try to solve the problem?
  - c. How does the main character solve the problem in the end?
- 4. Decide on the lessons the hero will learn during this journey of good versus evil.
- 5. Share your outline with a family member or friend.
- 6. Finally, as a challenge, try to write this. When you are finished, once again, share your work with a family member or friend.

- 1. What are the key characteristics of High Fantasy?
- 2. Describe the three approaches High Fantasy authors use when creating settings.
- 3. What traits will you find in the main character of High Fantasy?
- 4. What does the plot structure look like for a story of High Fantasy?
- 5. What are some lessons the hero might learn about during his/her journey? How can this be applied to the reader?
- 6. What are some famous examples of High Fantasy? Check one of these books out from the library and read it!
