| 1 | Rate <br> Man: <br> Ward: | ...the right pace! <br> Not a turtle or a rocket. <br> Not a crawl. Not a race... <br> Oh no! One of the Literacy Fiends is trying to read from the Secrets of Fluency Handbook but I can't understand him. <br> Fluency Friends, I am observing reading that seems way too fast. Send help! |
| 2 | Rate Man: | Rate Man here. Ward, I see 2 FAST has upped the speed as usual! Let's listen. |
| 3 | 2 Fast: | Not a turtle or a rocket. Not a crawl. Not a race. If you read like you talk, Then that's just the right pace! |
| 4 | Ward: | Is he fluent? |
| 5 | Rate Man: | No. 2 FAST, like many readers, struggles because he reads too fast. He mistakenly believes fast reading is good reading. <br> Also keep an eye out for 2 Fast's cousin, 2 Slow. He is just as hazardous to fluent reading <br> Reading too quickly or too slowly limits your ability to comprehend the meaning of text. Fluent reading is neither too fast nor too slow. It's done at a conversation pace, a speed similar to when you are talking to someone. |
| 6 | Ward: | What can I do to read at a good rate? |
| 7 | Rate Man: | Record your reading and compare it to how fast you talk. <br> Adjust your reading speed to go slower when the text is difficult or unfamiliar. <br> Try re-reading passages, increasing the speed as you become comfortable with the text. <br> Ward, why don't you show 2 Fast how to read the handbook at a fluent rate? |
| 8 | Ward: | Not a turtle or rocket. <br> Not a crawl. Not a race. <br> If you read like you talk, <br> Then that's just the right pace! |
| 9 | Rate Man: | Now that's the right rate! Until next time keep reading and be fluent. |
