1	QA4 Intro:	When you're asked a question about what you've read, think QA4! Question Answer Four. Look in the book or in your head. Think QA4! Question Answer Four. Use a strategy to get the answer right. Different reasoning is needed for each question type. To improve your studying and comprehension, think QA4! Think QA4! Think QA4! Yeah!
2	Voice- over Kid:	I've just read a passage on <i>The Rainy Day Game</i> . This question is asking, "What makes you feel proud?" How do I know the answer? It's asking <i>my opinion</i> . This is an "In My Head: On My Own" question.
3	Quoda:	Listen to Quoda and learn you will. Yes, the answer comes from within you. The correct response is found within your own thoughts, not the text. You will recognize these questions because they often ask: • What do you think? • What is your opinion? • How would you justify? • Would it be better if? Often you must explain why you answered as you did. These questions require you to evaluate, judge, choose, support, and give your opinion. How do you find the answer? You must rely on your own ideas, prior knowledge, and experience. If you connect them to the topic, the answer will be correct.
4	Voice- over Kid:	"What makes you feel proud?" "I feel proud when I can help someone."
5	Quoda:	Very good. Keep looking within yourself. You have the answer.
