## **Activities and Advice for Families**

- Sing songs and read books that use numbers and counting (**numbers**).
- Provide toys that have incremental sizes like nesting objects and stacking rings (measurement).
- Use comparison words when playing with big and little toys (**measurement**).
- Provide toys that provide problem solving (patterns and relationships).
- Provide your child with toys and materials with which he can build and explore (special sense).
- Provide opportunities for safe observation and exploration of your child's world (data collection and analysis).
- Maintain a daily routine (time and sequence).
